
Factory Radio Removal

- 1. Set parking brake and disconnect negative battery cable to prevent any electrical short.
- 2a. Automatic Transmission: Pry up gear shift trim ring and remove (Figure 1). Pry up ashtray trimpanel, disconnect harnesses and remove (Figure 2).
- 2b. Manual Transmission: Pry up gear shift trimpanel assembly from the rear edge to release clips (Figure 3). Unscrew gear shift knob. Lift assembly, disconnect wiring harness and remove (Figure 4).
- Remove two (2) phillips screws from console side trim (one from each side - Figure 5). Pry each side trim from dash to remove (Figure 6).



Factory Radio Removal (continued)

- 4. Remove six (6) phillips screws from factory radio/climate control assembly (three on each side of radio Figure 7).
- Remove two (2) plastic turn screws in black foot panel on driver's side.
 Pry out one (1) clip in center of panel. Pull down enough to remove four (4) phillips screws in back of plastic plug housing and remove panel (Figures 8 & 9).
- 6. Turn climate control to heat. Under driver's side of dash, release climate control cable and remove (Figure 10).
- 7. Pull out radio, disconnect wiring harnesses (including hazard switch harness) and antenna lead to remove (Figure 11).



• Inspect factory receiver harness connector in vehicle. Ensure that the wiring adaptor received from Crutchfield plugs into the vehicle's connector. If the connector is missing or incorrect, please call our Technical Support Department at 1-800-955-9094.

Receiver Installation (Vehicles with Manual Climate Controls Only)

- 1. Secure receiver, climate controls and hazard light switch to mounting bracket following instructions supplied with the installation kit.
- 2. Connect receiver wiring adaptor to receiver following instructions supplied with adaptor.
- 3. Hold receiver assembly near dash. Connect receiver wiring adaptor to factory harness. Make climate control harness connections. Plug antenna lead into rear of receiver.
- 4. Slide assembly into dash and secure with screws previously removed.
- 5. Test operation and reassemble dash by reversing removal steps.







- 1. Pry off "sail" panel starting at the top edge (Figure 1).
- 2. Pry out screw cover in door release trim. Remove one (1) exposed phillips screw (Figure 2).
- 3. Pry off front portion of door pull handle. Remove two (2) exposed phillips screws (Figure 3).
- 4. Pry around sides and bottom of door panel to release clips. Lift panel, disconnect wiring harnesses, door release and door lock cables. Remove panel (Figures 4 & 5).

















Front Door Speakers (continued)

5a. Tweeter Removal and Installation:

- Remove two (2) phillips screws securing speaker. Pull out speaker, disconnect and remove (Figure 6).
- Fabricate a speaker mounting bracket. Secure speaker to bracket.
- Connect speaker wiring adaptor to vehicle speaker harness.
- Secure speaker/bracket assembly.
- Test speaker operation.

5b. Woofer Removal and Installation:


- Remove three (3) phillips screws securing speaker. Pull out speaker, disconnect and remove (Figure 7).
- Secure speaker to adaptor bracket following instructions supplied with bracket.
- Place speaker/bracket assembly in location and use as a template to mark new mounting holes. Remove bracket and drill new holes with a 1/8" bit.
- Connect speaker wiring adaptor of replacement speaker to vehicle speaker harness.
- Secure speaker/bracket assembly.
- Test speaker operation and reinstall door panel by reversing removal steps.


